This is a collection of abstracts and translations from Rabbi Zacharia Emmich's Bris Book, 1851 through 1874 in the Archival Collection, Congregation Beth Israel, Houston.

In 1860, Congregation Beth Israel employed Rabbi Emmich the state's first full-time Jewish religious leader; however, his contact would not be renewed.

Why translate and transcribe this book? Because it demonstrates the importance of circumcision to Jewish families and is a ritual which dates to Biblical times and between as a covenant between God and Abraham upon the birth of his son, Isaac (Genesis 17:9-14).

In Texas, many newborn sons being circumcised were first-generation Americans born to recent immigrants. Many were also second-generation Texans.

Many infants whose births were celebrated did not live into adulthood. This translation may provide the only documentation of their short lives. Many infant graves in Texas Jewish cemeteries are unmarked, bear only the family surname, or have a tombstone that have eroded with time.

The original Bris Book is a bound book approximately 4" x 6" chronicling the circumcisions performed by Rabbi Emmich. A portion of the book is printed in German and Hebrew, followed by a handwritten section beginning on page 73 with the names and dates.

Rabbi **Zachariah Emmich** was born on 5 Nov 1817, Freidenberg am Mein, Baden, Germany. To date, the names of his parents are unknown.

Prior to coming to the United States, he received religious training in Frankfurt am Main.

On 18 Jun 1852, he emigrated and arrived in New York, NY aboard the *Ship Vesta* sailing from Antwerp, Belgium. He possibly had at least two brothers, **Morris Emmich** and **Isaac Emmich**.

On 25 Nov 1852, Lafayette, Tippecanoe Co., IN, Emmich married **Cecelia** "Cillie" Margolines / Magdalena. She was born on 28 Aug 1833, Germany. To date, the names of her parents are unknown. She possibly had at least

one sister, Rachel Margolines / Magdalena.

In 1853, he became a Naturalized Citizen in Lafayette, IN.

On 26 October 1858, he placed an ad in the Lafayette Daily Journal:

"Study of the German Language - Prof. Z. Emmich," *Lafayette Daily Journal* (Lafayette, Tippecanoe Co., IN), Tues., 26 Oct 1858, p. 2, c. 5

Prof. Z. Emmich has returned to this city, and will open an Evening School for the study of the German Language, during the course of the present week. A thorough education in Germany Seminary and fifteen years' experience in teaching that Language, enable Professor Emmich to guarantee to students a speedy acquirement of the German Language, Reading, Writing, and Conversation. Terms - in advance - Three Dollars for Sixteen Lessons

He and his family appear on the <u>1860 Federal Census</u>, Houston, Harris Co., TX. His occupation is listed as Hebrew Church, Pastor. Family members: Cillie Emmich, wife (age 26, b. Preußen); Ellen E. Emmich, daughter (age 5, b. IN); Rebecca Emmich, daughter (age 5, b. IN); Joseph Emmich, son (age 2, b. IA); and, Mary Emmich, daughter (age 5/12, b. MO).

In 1860, Emmich was hired as the first full-time rabbi in Texas. However, his contract was not renewed in 1862 he left full-time religious work and advertised himself as a "dealer in glassware, crockery, cutlery and groceries."

In the <u>1870 Federal Census</u>, Houston, Emmich is found with his family. His occupation is listed as retail crockery dealer. Family members: Cecelia Emmich, wife (age 39, b. Prussia); Ellen Emmich, daughter (age 15, b. IN); Rebecca Emmich, daughter (age 14, b. IN); Joseph Emmich, son (age 12, b. IA); Mary Emmich, daughter (age 10, b. MO); Sallie Emmich (age 6, b. TX); David Emmich, son (age 3, b. TX); and, Esther Emmich, daughter (age 1, b. TX).

Houston Daily Union (Houston, Harris Co., TX), Wed., 22 Feb 1871, p. 3, c. 1

Z. Emmich, on the same charge [depositing trash in the gutters], called for a jury who decided that he had a right to dirty the streets and rendered a verdict of not guilty.

Houston Daily Union (Houston, Harris Co., TX), Fri., 8 Sept 1871, p. 2, c. 5

Mr. Emmich formerly claimed to be a Republican and we believe, voted for Governor Davis. But the Democracy made him believe that they were going to win this time, and he thought he would jump over on the strong side. Poor old man! How disappointed and chop-fallen he will be when the Republicans gain the victory, as they certainly will! We pity him.

Galveston Daily News (Galveston, Galveston Co., TX), Wed., 17 Apr 1878, p. 4, c. 6

About 3 o'clock this morning the store of Z. Emmich was thought to be infested with burglars, but upon investigation the burglars proved to be a large black dog.

In the <u>1880 Federal Census</u>, Houston, Emmich is found with his family. His occupation is listed as greenware merchant (unfired ceramics). Family members: Cecilia Emmich, wife (age 47, b. Prussia); Joe Emmich, son (age 22, b. IL); Mary Emmich, daughter (age 20, b. MO); Sarah Emmich, daughter (age 16, b. TX); David Emmich, son (age 13, b. TX); Esther Emmich, daughter (age 11, b. TX); and, Jeanette Emmich, daughter (age 9, b. TX).

In the 1890 Houston City Directory, Zachariah Emmich, China, Glass, Queensware, Buist garden seeds, 36 Main between Congress and Franklin. It states he resided at 82 San Jacinto at the corner of Prairie.

Galveston Daily News (Galveston, Galveston Co., TX), Tue., 12 Jan 1892, p. 3, c. 2 Frightened a Robber

Between 8 and 9 o'clock last night a bold robber entered the bedroom of Mr. Z. Emmich through a window at his residence, southwest corner of San Jacinto and Prairie streets and stole a brown dressing gown, a present from his children and a back cloak.

While the robber was ransacking the room Mr. Emmich was asleep therein, and one of his daughters happened to visit the apartment for something and frightened the rascal off, making his escape through the window he had left open.

A watch chain and some money were not touched. Every member of the family except Mr. Emmich himself was awake.

He is found in the 1895-1896 Houston City Directory, living with his daughter and son-in-law Sidney I. Wolf.

In the <u>1900 Federal Census</u>, Houston, Emmich and his wife are living with their son Joseph. The census states Cecelia is the mother of 11 children with eight children living. Family members: Joseph Emmich, head (son of Zacharias, age 42, b. IA); Julia Emmich (wife of Joseph, age 36, b. TX); Leon Emmich (son of Joseph, age 13, b. TX); Zacharias Emmich (father of Joseph, age 81, b. Germany); and, Cecilia Emmich (wife of Zacharias, age 67, b. Germany).

He died on 22 Jan 1901, Houston, Harris Co., TX and is buried with his wife at Beth Israel Cemetery (West Dallas) (Sec. 63), Houston.

The remains of Zacharias Emmich, whose death occurred at his home, 1907 Preston avenue, Monday night (Jan 21st), were laid to rest yesterday morning in the Hebrew cemetery. Rabbi Barnstein of Congregation Beth Israel conducted the funeral services from the residence at 10 o'clock.

She was not found listed on the 1910 Federal Census, Houston.

Mrs. Emmich appears in the 1912 Houston City Directory living at 1907 Preston ave. and was the widow of Z. (Emmich). (p. 248) She appears in the 1915 Houston City Directory and it states she is boarding at 1108 Calhoun ave. and was the widow of Zack (Emmich). (p. 440)

With many of her friends, her children and her grandchildren, Mrs. Z. Emmich, 1108 Calhoun street, Saturday celebrated her eighty-second birthday and the fifty-seventh birthday since she arrived in Houston.

Kean in mind and interested in everything which is attracting national, state or city attention, she gathered her friends about her and together they spent the day in reviewing the past and looking to the future.

Mrs. Emmich came to the United States 63 years ago. Six years later, she came to Houston. She has lived here since that date. Her husband, Zach, was the first Jewish rabbi in Houston and was among the first of the city's citizens.

She has always been a believer in the Houston Ship Channel and with its completion has celebrated what she has hoped for and worked forever since the waterway was dreamed.

She was the recipient of many presents at her birthday party Saturday from both member of the family and friends.

Cecelia died on 10 Mar 1916, Houston and is buried with her husband.

Funeral services will be held from the residence at 1108 Calhoun avenue with interment in Beth Israel cemetery. Rabbi Henry Barnstein will officiate.

Houston Budget

This morning at 5 o'clock the death occurred of Mrs. Rebecca Dienstag, wife of Max Dienstag, a merchant of this city and daughter of the late Z. Emmich one of the old inhabitants of Houston.

She died at the family home at 1232 Prairie Avenue, in the 45th year of her age. She had not been able to be on the streets for some time, but her death was a surprise to friends here and in other parts of the state.

She grew to be very large and was perhaps the heaviest women in the city.

Houston Daily Post (Houston, Harris Co., TX), Wed., 4 Jan 1899, p. 10, c. 4

Max Dienstag came to Houston on January 4, 1874, from Brookhaven, Miss. At that time, there was no rail connection between New Orleans and Texas. He arrived by steamer at Galveston. [He was] engaged in a small business at the Market house selling crockery and glassware, etc. [He] gave that up after a few months to assume position with the crockery house of Z. Emmich serving in the capacity of manager for the house for nearly fifteen years.

He resigned that position in 1889 to embark in business. [He] continued his calling by opening a crockery and glassware business, known as "Dienstag's China Parlor," at 407 Main street, occupying then only a space of 25 x 60 feet. His business continued to grow and prosper until today he occupies the entire three story building, with additional warehouse facilities.

_____ application to business, ever studying the wants of his patrons with a continued effort to please them, Mr. Dienstag has built up a creditable business.

The complements in the business are: A. Dienstag, bookkeeper; Mrs. T. Lippet, clerk; E. M. Taylor, clerk; and, George Leake, porter.

Mr. Dienstag married the daughter of his employer, Mr. Emmich in January 1877 and has every reason to be proud of his advert in Houston.

4. **Joseph "Joe" Emmich** (married: Julia Emmich) (5 Feb 1858, IA - 8 Sep 1914, TX) - Burial: Beth Israel Cemetery (West Dallas) (Sec. 91), Houston.

Joe and Julia were double first cousins. Julia was the daughter of Isaac Emmich (brother of Zachariah) and Rachael Margolines / Magdalena (sister of Cecelia). They were married on 24 Jan 1886, Houston.

He is found in the 1886-1887 Houston City Directory listed as a bookkeeper for Z. Emmich living with same. (p. 124) He is found in the 1895-1896 Houston City Directory as a city salesman for Polemanako Fruit & Candy Co. and resides at 1301 Capitol Ave. at the corner of Caroline.

Joseph Emmich, aged 56 years, died at his home at 1108 Calhoun avenue Tuesday evening at 9 o'clock. Mr. Emmich had resided in Houston for 54 years prior to his death.

His is survived by his widow, Mrs. Julia Emmich; one son, Leon Emmich; his mother, Mrs. J. Emmich; five sisters, Mrs. Ellen Myer of Baton Rouge, La., Mrs. Charles Bridge of Seattle, Wash., Mrs. Robert Blei of San Francisco, Cal., Mrs. S. I. Wolf and Mrs. Jonas Dannenbaum of Houston. He is also survived by a brother, Dave Emmich of Houston.

She is survived by her son and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Leon Emmich; four sisters, Mrs. James Davis, Mrs. Barbara Levy, Mrs. Sara Emmich and Mrs. Jonas Dannenbaum, and several nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Emmich, although inactive for the past several years due to illness, never lost her interest in her house of worship, being a member of Temple Beth Israel, where her father [(sic) father-in-law], Zachariah Emmich once ministered.

During the major part of her lifetime, she was a member of the Congregation Ladies Auxiliaries and was an active worker in all their causes.

She was born and reared in Houston. She left Houston we she married; but made frequent visits here with relatives and friends. After the death of Mr. Blei, six years ago, Mrs. Blei returned to Houston to live.

Mrs. Blei is survived by four sisters, Mrs. Julia Emmich [(sic) sister-in-law], with whom she lived; Mrs. Jonas Dannenbaum and Mrs. Sidney Wolf, all of Houston and Mrs. Charles Bridges of Seattle, Washington, and many nieces and nephews.

Brief funeral services were held at the residence, 2213 Chenevert at 8:15 p.m. Wednesday, with Rabbi Henry Barnston officiating. After the services, the body was sent to San Antonio by the Settegast-Kopf Company for cremation.
