Livestreaming Instructions

For all Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur Services

To access the livestream of all High Holy Days Services on your computer, tablet, or phone, please follow the instructions below:

1. Type the link below into your browser
www.beth-israel.org/worship-lifecycle/worship/highholydays/
2. Make sure your volume is turned on/up
3. To expand the screen, you will click the little box at the bottom right

Zoom Instructions

Zoom links and passwords have been provided in the program for the *Cemetery Service and Afternoon Alternative Insights & Discussion*

To access the Zoom Services on your computer, tablet, or phone, please follow the instructions below:

1. Go to zoom.us
2. Click "Sign Up - It's Free" at the upper right, OR
Go to the "Resources" tab at the upper right and click on "Download Zoom Client"
3. Follow the instructions listed

Note: if you click on a link to join a Zoom and do not already have Zoom installed, you will be prompted to download the app before you can join the call.

4. Join a Zoom Call

Tips for Participating

There is a menu of options at the bottom of your screen (if you don't see the menu, just move your cursor to or tap the bottom of your screen, and it will pop up):

- Stop Video - This option turns off your webcam. You can still see others, but they cannot see you.
- Chat - This opens a panel where you can type a question or make a comment. Within the panel, you will have options for chatting with everyone or selecting a specific participant.
- React - Hover over your own panel during the conference, you will see applause and thumbs up emojis. Click one to make your selection
- Leave Meeting - When the meeting ends (or when you need to go), click here or simply close the app.

We recommend that you install the latest internet browser and system updates on the device(s) that you will be using to watch the High Holy Days Services.
